- 1. <u>Colossians 1:11</u> It is written: I am strengthened with all might, according to His glorious power, for all patience and longsuffering with joy.
- 2. <u>Ephesians 3:16</u> It is written: that He grants me, according to the riches of His glory, to be strengthened with might through His Spirit in the inner man.
- 3. <u>Philippians 4:13</u> It is written: I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me.
- 4. <u>2 Samuel 22:33</u> It is written: God is my strength and power, and He makes my way perfect.
- 5. <u>Luke 22:43</u> It is written: His angels can appear from heaven, and strengthen me.

- 6. <u>2 Corinthians 12:9</u> It is written: But He said to me, "My grace is sufficient for you, for my power is made perfect in weakness." Therefore I will boast all the more gladly about my weaknesses, so that Christ's power may rest on me.
- 7. <u>2 Timothy 4:17</u> It is written: But the Lord stands at my side and gives me strength, so that through me the message might be fully proclaimed and all the unsaved might hear it. And I am delivered from the lion's mouth.
- 8. <u>1 Peter 5:10</u> It is written: And the God of all grace, who called me to his eternal glory in Christ, after I have suffered a little while, will himself restore me and make me strong, firm and steadfast.
- 9. Nehemiah 8:10 It is written: for the joy of the Lord is my strength.
- 10. <u>Psalm 18:2</u> It is written: The Lord is my rock and my fortress and my deliverer; My God, my strength, in whom I will trust; My shield and the horn of my salvation, my stronghold.
- 11. <u>Psalm 18:32</u> It is written: It is God who arms me with strength and makes my way perfect.
- 12. <u>Psalm 18:39</u> It is written: For you have armed me with strength for the battle; You have subdued under me those who rose up against me.
- 13. <u>Psalm 20:2</u> It is written: He sends me help from the sanctuary, and strengthens me out of the Church.
- 14. <u>Psalm 20:6</u> It is written: Now this I know, the Lord gives victory to his anointed. He answers him from his heavenly sanctuary with the victorious power of his right hand.
- 15. <u>Psalm 22:19</u> It is written: But You O Lord, do not be far from Me; O My strength, hasten to help me!
- 16. <u>Psalm 27:1</u> It is written: The Lord is my light and my salvation; whom shall I fear? The Lord is the strength of my life; of whom shall I be afraid?
- 17. <u>Psalm 27:14</u> It is written: Wait on the Lord; be strong and take heart and wait for the Lord.
- 18. <u>Psalm 28:7</u> It is written: The Lord is my strength and my shield; My heart trusted in Him, and I am helped; Therefore, my heart greatly rejoices, and with my song I will praise Him.
- 19. <u>Psalm 28:8</u> It is written: The Lord is the strength of his people, a fortress of salvation for his anointed one.
- 20. <u>Psalm 29:11</u> It is written: The Lord will give strength to His people; The Lord will bless His people with peace.

- 21. <u>Psalm 31:4</u> It is written: Pull me out of the net which they have secretly laid for me, for You are my strength
- 22. <u>Psalm 31:24</u> It is written: I am courageous, and He shall strengthen my heart, because I hope in the Lord.
- 23. <u>Psalm 37:39</u> It is written: But the salvation of the righteous is from the Lord; He is my strength in time of trouble.
- 24. <u>Proverbs 3:7-8</u> It is written: I am not wise in my own eyes; I fear the Lord and shun evil. This will bring health to my body and nourishment to my bones.
- 25. <u>Proverbs 10:29</u> It is written: The way of the Lord is strength for the upright, but destruction will come to the workers of iniquity.
- 26. <u>Isaiah 12:2</u> It is written: Behold, God is my salvation, I will trust and not be afraid; for YAH the Lord, is my strength and song; He also has become my salvation.
- 27. <u>Isaiah 26:4</u> It is written: Trust the Lord forever, for in YAH, the Lord, is everlasting strength.
- 28. <u>Isaiah 30:15</u> It is written: For thus says the Lord God, the Holy One of Israel: "In returning and rest you shall be saved; in quietness and confidence shall be your strength."
- 29. <u>Isaiah 40:9</u> It is written: He gives power to the weak, and to those who have no might He increases strength.
- 30. <u>Isaiah 40:31</u> It is written: But those who wait on the Lord shall renew their strength; They shall mount up with wings like eagles, They shall run and not be weary, they shall walk and not faint.
- 31. <u>Isaiah 41:10</u> It is written: Fear not, for I am with you; Be not dismayed for I am your God. I will strengthen you, Yes, I will help you, I will uphold you with my righteous right hand.
